THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT I

That in or about October 2002 and continuing to in or about
March 2010, in the District of Montana, JAMES ZANDER, did willfully
attempt to evade and defeat the payment of an income tax due and
owing by him to the United States of America for the calendar year
2001, by concealing and attempting to conceal from the Internal
Revenue Service the nature and extent of his assets; making false
statements to agents of the Internal Revenue Service; and placing funds
and property in the names of nominees, in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7201.

COUNT II

That in or about February 2002 and continuing to in or about
March 2010, in the District of Montana, JAMES ZANDER did corruptly
endeavor to obstruct and impede the due administration of the internal
revenue laws by sending frivolous correspondence to the Internal
Revenue Service, Cascade County Clerk and Recorder, and Stockman
Bank; asserting frivolous claims and demands against Internal Revenue
Service and Cascade County employees; sending fictitious financial
instruments to the Secretary of the Treasury; using nominee companies

to conceal assets and disguise income; and filing false tax returns, in violation of 26 U.S.C. 7212(a).
